



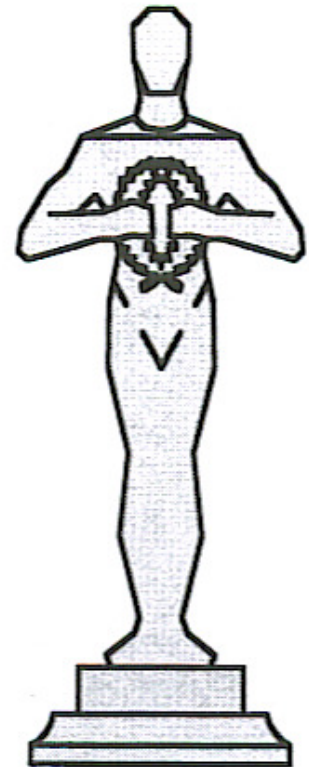

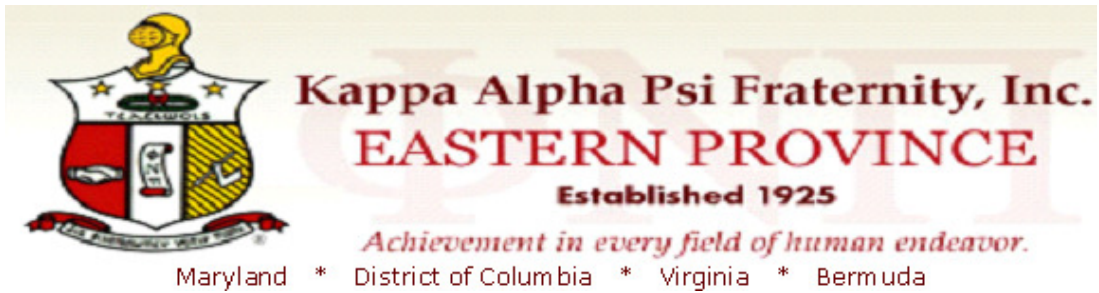

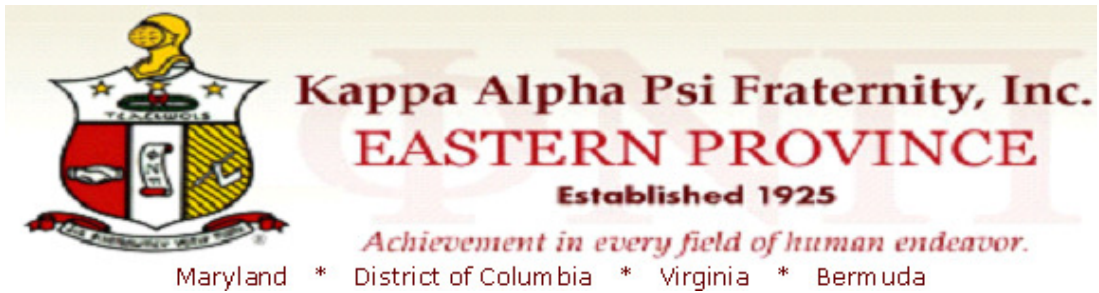

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.
- If graduating prior to the spring of the contest year, he must show proof of admission or acceptance to graduate school
- Must be financial w/ local chapter, province and Grand Chapter
- Must have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Must be able to exhibit their skills and abilities

AREAS TO BE JUDGED

Awareness:

- Awareness of events in all aspects of life: politics, education, world affairs, etc.

Career Preparation:

- A written statement of contestant's Career Choice. Use the enclosed **Profile of Career Choice** as a guide for the statement content

Poise:

- Introduce self and give a brief statement of his philosophy of life

Scholarship:

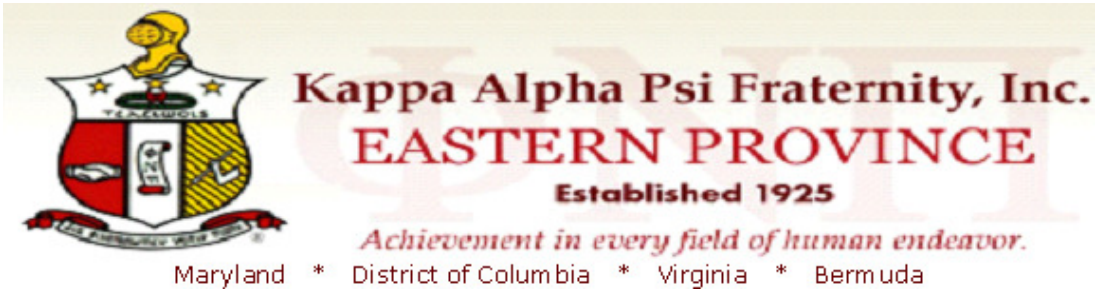
- Grade point average will be determined by a sealed, official transcript

School/Community Activities:

- A listing of school and community activities, organizational memberships, offices held, etc.

Talent:

- Verbal, musical, and visual presentations that will exhibit the skills and abilities of the contestant
- The contestant must furnish musical instruments and materials, except for a piano, if required. Only a piano accompanist will be provided, if requested in advance. Talent presentations must be limited to four (4) minutes. If a contestant exceeds the time limit, points will be deducted from the contestant's talent score.

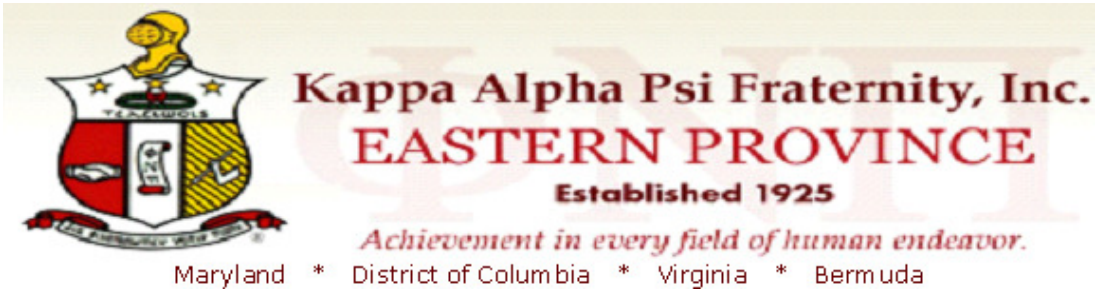

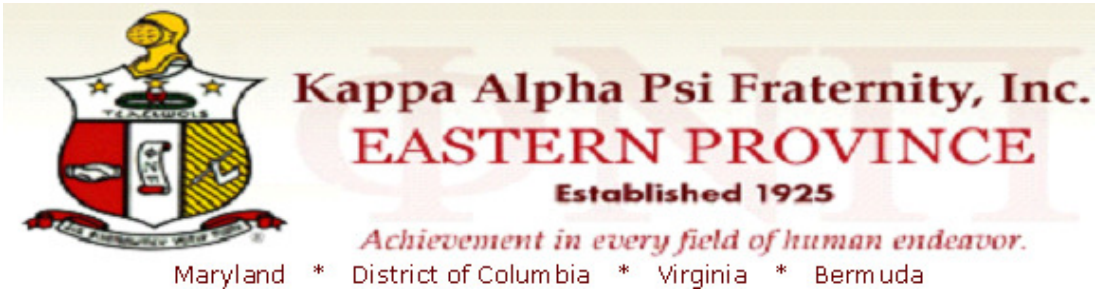
